PROJECT SCOPE:

The proposed “Quarry in Pangnirtung” project is located within the Qikiqtani (South Baffin) region, approximately one (1) kilometres (km) north of Pangnirtung. The Proponent intends to extract aggregate from a new quarry to complement the existing quarry to meeting the increasing demands of the community. The program is proposed to take place from October 2019 to October 2020. The scope of this proposed project as identified by the NIRB includes the following undertakings, works or activities:

- Construction of a new quarry to access additional aggregate material
- Extraction of up to 80,000 cubic metres of (gravel, sand, silt and rip rap)
- Transport of material for use in community
- Waste to be collected in bins and disposed of in local dump

Parties are also invited to recommend any specific mitigation measures they feel would be appropriate, and to bring any other matter of importance related to this project proposal to the NIRB’s attention.
