**Re: Comments on the Draft Agenda for the upcoming Public Hearing for the NIRB's Assessment of the Phase 2 Proposal**

Dear Solomon,

Baffinland has reviewed the Draft Agenda circulated September 16, 2019 for the upcoming Public Hearing for the Nunavut Impact Review Board (the Board)'s assessment of the Phase 2 Proposal and offers the following recommendations for the Board's consideration:

- Increase the time allotted to the Terrestrial Environment session on Day 1 from 45 minutes to 60 minutes.
- Explicitly include 'Adaptive Management' in the Management Plans and Monitoring Programs session as follows, "Adaptive Management, Management Plans and Monitoring Programs".

Should any intervenors request revisions to any of the topics or allocated time to the specific topics described in the Technical Sessions, Baffinland requests an opportunity to engage with NIRB before the Final Agenda is released on October 11, 2019, as Baffinland has already carried out significant work to develop presentations based on the topics and timing described in the Draft Agenda.

At this time, Baffinland confirms the participation of the individuals described in Appendix A to this letter in the public hearing.
