Hello Kelli:

For your information in the monitoring of the Whale Tail Pit project, I wanted to let you know that Natural Resources Canada has issued a licence under Subsection 7(1)(a) of the *Explosives Act* for the operation of an emulsion storage and transfer facility at the mine site. The building, including storage tanks and bays for two Mobile Processing Units, was recently constructed by Agnico Eagle as part of the Whale Tail Pit Project. Ammonium nitrate emulsion, produced at the licenced Meadowbank emulsion plant, will be transferred and stored at the Whale Tail facility to allow the continuation of blasting when haul road closures prevent the travel of explosives trucks between the emulsion plant and the Whale Tail mine.
