Re.: Baffinland’s Phase 2 Proposal

Dear Ms. Kaviq Kaluraq,

I am writing this letter to inform you that the Qikiqtani Inuit Association (QIA) is not prepared to endorse or support Baffinland’s Phase 2 Proposal currently before the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB).

On October 30, 2019, QIA’s board of directors held a special meeting to discuss our ongoing work on Baffinland’s Phase 2 Proposal. At that meeting, our board members unanimously voted to not endorse or support the Proposal at this time.

Many of QIA’s environmental and cultural concerns regarding Baffinland’s Phase 2 proposal have not been adequately resolved. We are also concerned that there are issues raised by impacted communities that have not yet been addressed.

As you know, QIA fully participated in the NIRB review of the Phase 2 Proposal. Some of QIA’s environmental and cultural concerns have been addressed, but numerous and significant issues remain unresolved.

Many of these unresolved issues directly implicate assessing, monitoring, and adaptive management for Inuit culture and land use.

In the past few months our organization has been working closely with impacted Mary River communities including: Arctic Bay, Cape Dorset, Clyde River, Hall Beach, Igloolik, Kimmirut, and Pond Inlet. We have hosted a number of meetings with community representatives from impacted hamlets with the most recent taking place on October 7 in Iqaluit.
