TITLE: Water Supply Studies of Unnamed Lake, Iqaluit NU

OBJECTIVES OF RESEARCH:

The City of Iqaluit has been experiencing water shortages in its drinking water reservoir, Lake Geraldine. As part of planning for the future growth of the City, the City is studying potential new sources of drinking water to supplement the Lake Geraldine reservoir. In summer and fall of 2019, the City plans to continue with studies of the "Unnamed Lake" approximately 3 kilometres north of the Road to Nowhere. These studies will help to answer whether this lake could reliably supply enough water every year to permanently add to the City's drinking water supply. Currently, very little is known about this lake, its depth, how much water flows in and out and the quality of the water.
