RE: NPC File # 149269 [Ulu Gold Project]

The following works and activities have been proposed in the above-noted project proposal:

1. Location: Kitikmeot Region;
2. Renewal and amendment to NWB water licenses NWB2ULU9700, NWB1ULU0008, 2BMULU0914 and 2BMULU1520
3. Proponent wishes to restart project and to undertake the following project modifications: establish a new soil treatment facility; establish a new non-hazardous waste landfill; establish an alternate exploration camp location; utilize alternate industrial and domestic water supplies; increase water withdrawal volume to 200 m³/day.

The Nunavut Planning Commission (NPC) has determined that this project proposal is outside the area of an applicable regional land use plan. The Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB) previously screened the works and activities associated with the current proposal, (NIRB FILE NO. 99WR055, 04EN014, and 05EN007).

The NPC has determined that the above-noted project proposal is a significant modification to the project because of the additional proposed uses and changes in location.

The above-noted project proposal requires screening by the NIRB under section 12.4.3 of the Nunavut Agreement as amended because it is for a component or activity that was not part of the original or previously amended proposal and its inclusion is a significant modification of the project.
