The initial Licence has the following Components;

1. Pump station at Char Lake
2. Intake from Char lake to Signal Hill water Plant
3. Water treatment Plant at signal Hill
4. Utilidor system- water line and sewer line
5. Macirator system.
6. Proposed new wastewater treatment Plant

Licence type was type B.

During Amendment :

1. New Pump station at Signal Hill: Construction stage
2. Upgrade of existing water treatment plant: Construction stage
3. Upgrade of intake line: construction is complete
4. Upgrade of Utilidor system-Water line and sewer line: Construction is complete
5. Existing Macirator unit: As it is
6. Proposed new wastewater treatment Plant- design stage

This is also type B and existing now.

Water Board 's new regulations;

If water extraction volume is more than 300 cubic meters per day or storage volume is 60,000 cubic meters annually, the water licence will be considered as Type A.

Today, we need to satisfy this criteria and changing the Type B to Type A.

These have nothing to do with the number of infrastructure.
