Discussions are currently in-progress between the Canada-Nunavut Geoscience Office (CNGO) and TMAC Resources Ltd. regarding a collaborative mapping and research program on the Hope Bay and Elu Greenstone belts. TMAC has agreed to provide the following with rates (if described):

- Transportation to and from Yellowknife, NT or Edmonton, AB for personnel and equipment into Doris Camp through private charter services (pending flight availability);
 - Personal gear and equipment must not exceed 40lbs;
 - Exceeded weights accepted if shipping arranged in advance.
- Accommodation and food at Doris camp a rate of \$220/day per person (subject to change);
- Helicopter requirements:
 - Restricted helicopter pad use for contract services with 12V power source;
 - Helicopter office/storage at site;
 - Jet-A drums or bulk fuel.
- Jet-A fuel at a rate of:
 - \$417.67/drum/205L; or
 - \$2.04/L bulk fuel (moving average price, subject to change).
- Tentative program dates:
 - July 16-August 13;
 - 6 personnel (subject to approval from TMAC Management);
 - Weekly I/B and O/B flights from Yellowknife, NT and/or Edmonton, AB on Tuesday and Thursdays.
