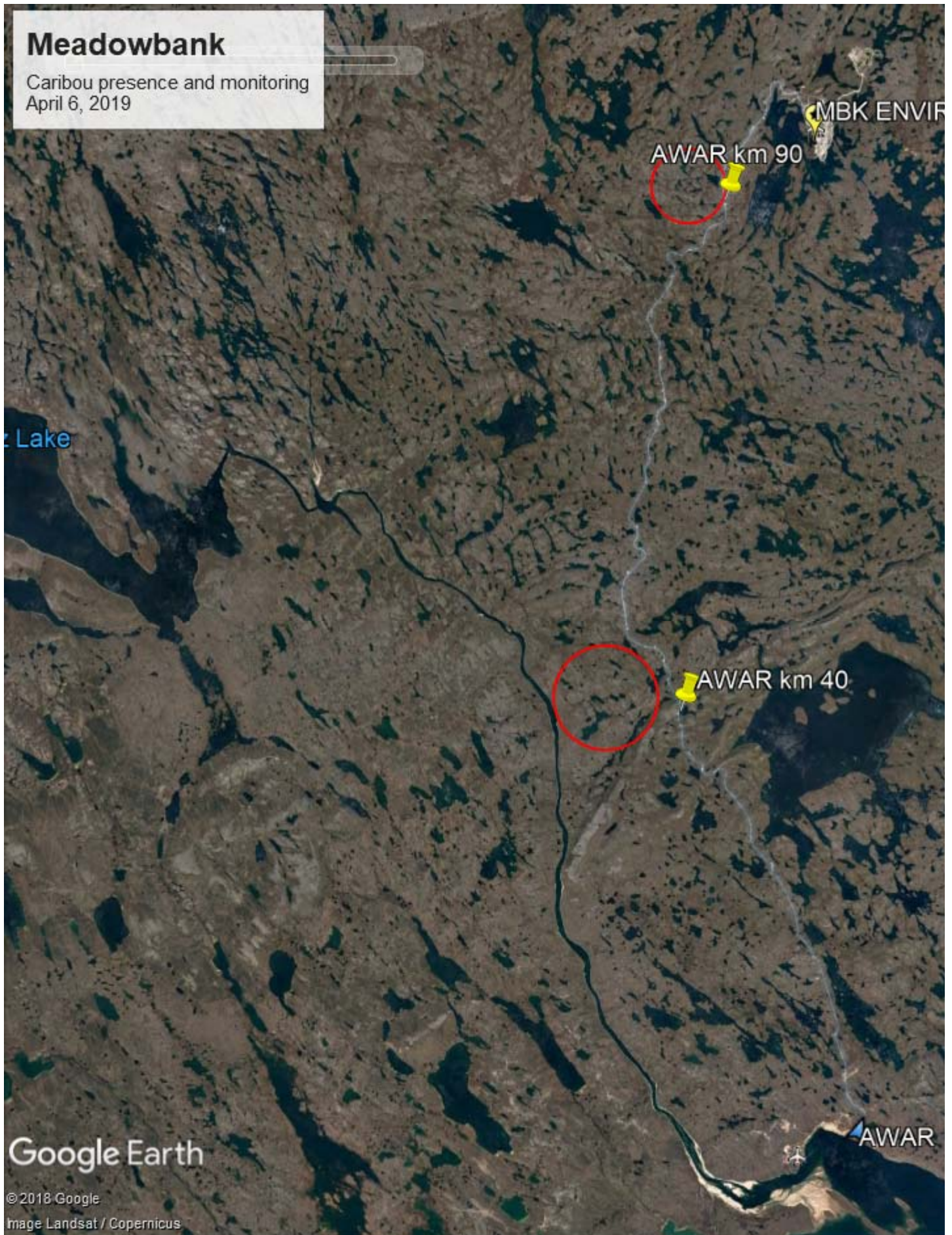

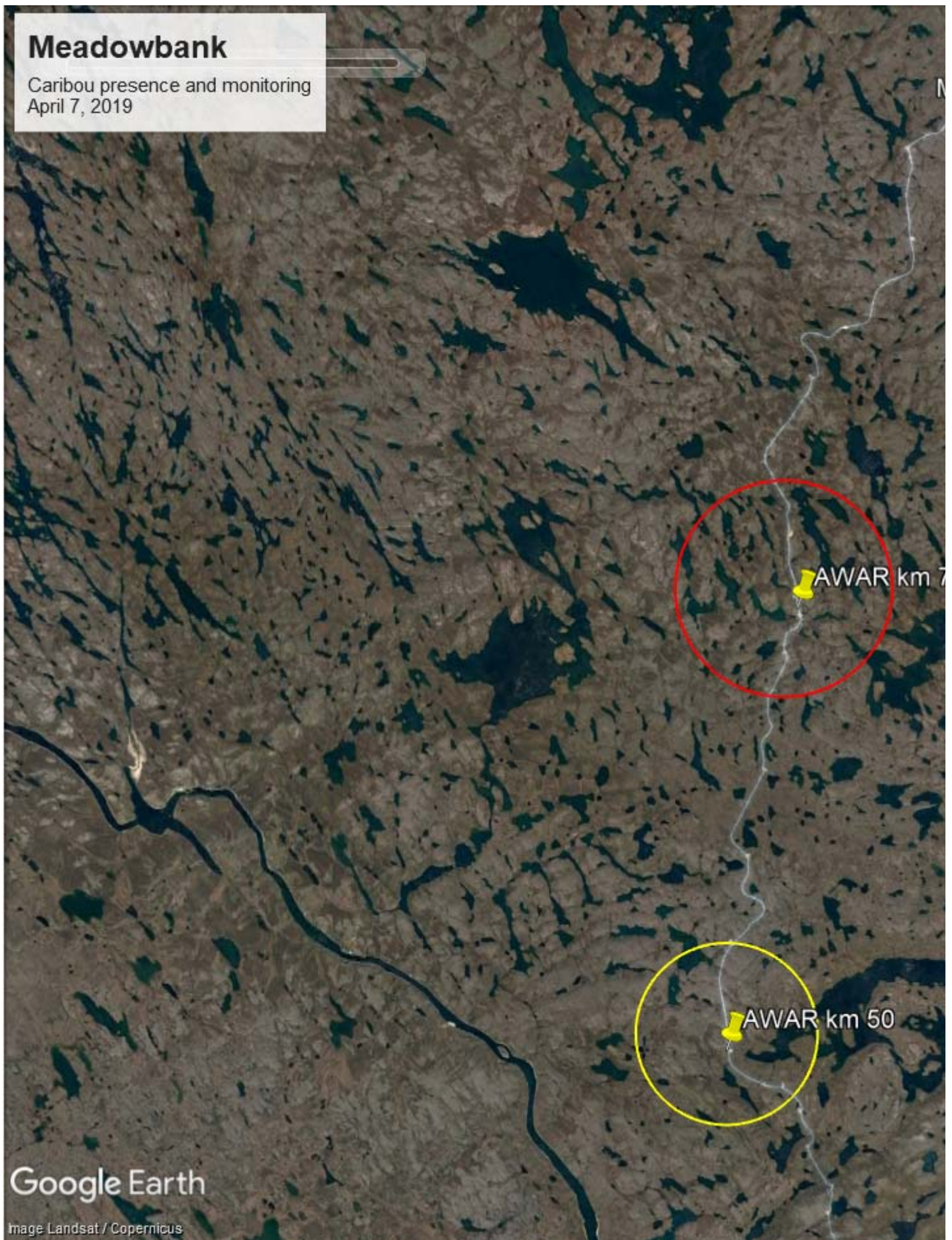

Good day

We want to inform you the presence of caribou close to Amaruq site.





At 9h45 we receive a notification for a presence of 50 caribou at the Km 178 on the East side of the road. Approximately one hour later we received another notification for 200-400 caribou were at 200 meters from the road km 178. The wildlife monitors (HTO member and our environment helper) were there at that time. We asked to reduce the speed around this area (km 177 to Amaruq site). We did a monitoring during the morning and we decided to close the road as we saw the group increasing. The road was close for the traffic at 12h00. And we keep it close until tomorrow. We will monitor tomorrow morning and evaluate if we keep the road close or not.

A rough estimate of the herd is 1000-2000 caribou.
