 - a. 149350: 100,000 cubic metres of material.

2. Location: Kivalliq Region; [existing quarries within municipal boundaries of Baker Lake]

Proponents may not carry out projects and regulatory authorities may not issue licenses, permits and other authorizations in respect of projects if a review by the NPC is required. Regulatory authorities may consult with the NPC to obtain recommendations on their duties to implement the existing land use plans prior to issuing licenses, permits and other authorizations under subsection 69(6) of the NUPPAA.
