Re: NIRB Update Regarding Operations and Monitoring for the 2020-21 Annual Monitoring Year

Dear Ms Reimer and Ms Koide,

Agnico Eagle Mines Limited (Agnico Eagle) wishes to update you on its Meadowbank Complex Operations in Nunavut.

At the present time, there are no confirmed cases of COVID-19 at the Meadowbank Complex site.

Agnico Eagle is committed to protect the health, safety and well-being of its employees and communities and has been working to ensure correct protocols and safety precautions are in place in all its operations. In Nunavut, according to public health authorities' recommendations, measures have been put in place to eliminate any interactions between the mine personnel and local communities.

Further to the correspondence received by the NIRB on May 7, 2020, Agnico Eagle reviewed all of its Terms and Conditions of its Project Certificates in light of the current pandemic. We are committed to fulfill our obligations for environmental protection and monitoring requirements. Where Terms and Conditions require input from local communities or to hold meetings or workshops, Agnico Eagle is adapting its strategy to continue to gather input and provide updates through teleconferences and Facebook posts in order to respect the measures to eliminate the physical interactions with local communities. Should these measures be required to stay in place throughout the shipping season, Agnico Eagle is currently evaluating alternatives to address the requirement of placing local marine mammal monitors onboard all vessels carrying fuel or other materials for the Project through Chesterfield Inlet (NIRB Project Certificate [no.:004] Term and Condition 36).
