The following works and activities have been proposed in the above-noted project proposal:

1. Landfarm: Amendment of existing licenses to install and operate an outdoor biomedical waste incinerator in their current Environmental Waste Processing Facility.
2. Associated NPC FILE No: 148158, 149195, Associated NIRB FILE No: 15XN051
3. Summary of modification: Operate a biomedical waste incinerator.
4. Location: Qikiqtani Region [Iqaluit, within municipal boundaries]

The Nunavut Planning Commission (NPC) has determined that this project proposal is outside the area of an applicable regional land use plan. The Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB) previously screened the works and activities

associated with the current proposal, including the management of hazardous and non-hazardous waste, hydrocarbon impacted water treatment and contaminated soil management (NIRB FILE NO. 15XN051).

The NPC has determined that the above-noted project proposal is a significant modification to the project because of the installation and operation of a biomedical waste incinerator, that was not part of the previously reviewed project proposal.

The above-noted project proposal requires screening by the NIRB under section 12.4.3 of the Nunavut Agreement as amended because it is for a component or activity that was not part of the original or previously amended proposal and its inclusion is a significant modification of the project. By way of this letter, the NPC is forwarding the project proposal with this determination to the NIRB for screening. Project materials are available at the following address:
