In response to the Nunavut Impact Review Boards (NIRB) June 30, 2020 request of the abilities of parties to participate in the assessment of Agnico Eagle Mines Saline Effluent Discharge to Marine Environment Proposal for Meliadine Gold Mine, Environment Climate Change Canada (ECCC) is providing the following response.

- a) **Process timelines** – ECCC continues to maintain operations at as close to normal as possible and should be able to meet timelines set by the NIRB for this process.
- b) **Meeting format** – ECCC preference would be for of written and verbal formats. ECCC's expertise is primarily based outside Nunavut and in-person public meetings may prove difficult for our attendance with current or future travel restrictions.
