Re.: 14EN033 & 19EA019, Hood River Project: activities and reporting

The purpose of this letter is outline Blue Star Gold Corp.'s (Blue Star) current and planned activities in relation to the two Screening Decisions issued by the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB) for its Hood River Gold Project, and confirm its understanding of reporting requirements moving forward.

Blue Star's predecessor undertook screening for its Hood River Project in 2014 (14EN033). This project involved exploration activities and use of the adjacent Ulu camp for accommodation, domestic water use and waste deposit as well as fuel storage. This program, based out of Ulu, was completed in 2014.

In 2019, Blue Star updated its plans for the Hood River Gold Project, to continue exploration activities but also to establish a camp at Hood River and undertake environmental baseline studies (19EN019).

Accordingly, as activities screened under 14EN033 have either been completed or continued under 19EN019, following discussion with the NIRB, it is Blue Star's understanding that only requirements under 19EN019 need to be fulfilled; reporting in accordance with the Screening Decision Report issued for 14EN033 is no longer required.
