## PROJECT SCOPE:

The proposed “Arctic Haven Runway Overlay” project is located within the Kivalliq region, approximately 400 kilometres (km) from Arviat. The Proponent intends to conduct to amend the scope of previously approved activities to extend the existing airstrip. The program is proposed to take place from June 12, 2020 to October 9, 2025. The scope of this proposed project as identified by the NIRB includes the following undertakings, works or activities:

- Extension to the length of the existing airstrip using existing material currently on the airstrip during the operational season of June to September
- Use of heavy machinery including a bulldozer, excavator, dump truck and compactor to extend the airstrip
- Use and storage of approximately 5000 Litres (L) of diesel fuel within secondary containment
- Continuing use of existing road
