The following is Nunavut Tunngavik Inc.'s (NTI) response to the information request of the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB) relating to participation in the Community Roundtable and Pre-Hearing Conference for Baffinland Iron Mines Corp's "Phase 2 Development" Project scheduled from September 28 to October 1, 2020.

In addition to the representatives above, Arthur Yuan (Legal Counsel) and Neida Gonzalez (Legal Counsel) will participate in the Pre-Hearing Conference (Southern Hub – Ottawa).

NTI requests that NIRB remain flexible regarding participation to ensure meaningful Inuit participation in the review process. NTI continues to stress that it is vital that NIRB make available simultaneous Inuktitut interpretation for the Community Roundtable and the Pre-Hearing Conference and recommends that a separate Inuktitut line or channel be made available to participants as necessary.



NTI also reiterates that NIRB should verify with community representatives that they have been able to access digital copies of available materials contained within NIRB's public registry and if community representatives have been unable to access relevant materials that NIRB facilitate access to these materials.

NTI may also invite other staff to take notes during the Community Roundtable and Pre-Hearing Conference.
