PROJECT SCOPE:

The proposed “Quarry Sites KM 8, 15, 16, 18, 20” project is located within the Kivalliq region, northwest of the community of Rankin Inlet, within municipal boundaries. The Proponent intends to extract aggregate from five (5) quarry sites to meet the construction demands of the community of Rankin Inlet. The program is proposed to take place from 2021 until the projected deposits of aggregate are depleted or no longer needed. The scope of this proposed project as identified by the NIRB includes the following undertakings, works or activities:

- Construction of new quarry sites to access aggregate material for community construction needs
- Use of equipment including excavator, loader, dump trucks, crusher
- Use of heavy equipment to widen the Diane Road from three (3) metres to eight (8) metres to accommodate two-way heavy equipment traffic
- Construction of two (2) roads branching off Diane Road to access quarries KM 8 and 15
