Dear Ms. Copland,

This is in response to your letter of April 21, 2017, addressed to the Honourable Carolyn Bennett, regarding the screening decision of the Nunavut Impact Review Board for Agnico Eagle Mines Ltd. for its "Parker Lake Temporary Exploration Camp and Airstrip and Cone Hill Exploration" Project Proposal, Kivalliq Region, Nunavut (NIRB 15EN049, NPC 148439).

Under section 92(1) of the *Nunavut Planning and Project Assessment Act*, the Nunavut Impact Review Board must submit a written report to the responsible Minister. The Nunavut Impact Review Board has recommended, pursuant to paragraph 92(1)(a) of the *Nunavut Planning and Project Assessment Act*, that a review of the project is not required. The Nunavut Impact Review Board has also recommended specific terms and conditions that are appropriate for this project. On the Minister's behalf, I agree that a review of the project is not required and pursuant to 93(1)(a) of the *Nunavut Planning and Project Assessment Act* that the assessment of the project has been completed and the proponent may carry out the project, subject to s. 74(f) and the proponent obtaining any licence, permit or other authorization required by law. I would like to thank the Nunavut Impact Review Board for its diligence in reviewing this proposal.


