RE: NPC File # 149424 [Kugluktuk Power Plant and Solar Project]

The following works and activities have been proposed in the above-noted project proposal:

1. Construction of new power plant including a solar farm, and a bulk fuel storage facility.
2. Modifications to the original/amended project proposal: expansion and addition of a new location on the opposite side of the road.
3. Associated NPC File No: 149022, Associated NIRB File No: 19XN011.
4. Location: Kitikmeot Region; [Kugluktuk; within municipal boundaries]

The Nunavut Planning Commission (NPC) previously reviewed works and activities associated with the current project proposal including the construction of a new power plant facility and a determination was issued on January 28, 2018 (NPC file 149022) that it is outside the area of an applicable regional land use plan.

In addition, works and activities associated with the current proposal were previously screened by the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB FILE NO.: 19XN011).

The above-noted project proposal is exempt from screening by the NIRB because the NPC is of the understanding that the expansion of the project area and the addition of a new location on the opposite side of the road does not change the general scope of the original or previously amended project activities, and the exceptions noted in Section 12.4.3 (a) and (b) of the Nunavut Agreement do not apply.

By way of this letter, the NPC is forwarding the project proposal to the regulatory authorities identified by the proponent. Project materials are available at the following address:
