On behalf of the KIA, the proposed updated wording for commitment #15 is as follows:

- a. A call will be held with interested parties to review the framework of the Adaptive Management Plan. (KivIA, ECCC, CIRNA). The Adaptive Management Plan will include a decision tree specifying the conditions under which surface water will be diverted into the saline effluent waterlines for marine disposal and the volumes that will be diverted under those conditions. The decision tree will be designed such that discharges to Meliadine Lake are minimized.
- b. Agnico Eagle will provide an update on the framework of the Adaptive Management Plan
