**RE: NPC File # 149439 [1990s caribou camp and fuel cache clean-up (Ahiak Migratory Bird Sanctuary)]**

The following works and activities have been proposed in the above-noted project proposal:

1. Caribou camp cleanup/remediation within the Ahiak (Queen Maud Gulf) Migratory Bird Sanctuary.
2. The site consists of at least 44 full drums of fuel, and 23 partial or empty drums.
3. A crew of 4 will visit the site via helicopter in August 2021 (or 2022 if cancelled due to COVID), camp on site for 5 days (1 day in, 3 working days, 1 day out), dig out all drums, and then sling all drums and wood and waste to a suitable location where it could be picked up by twin otter in 2022 (or 2023 if cancelled due to COVID) depending on PCSP's flight plans between March and September and taken to Cambridge Bay for disposal.
4. Location: Kitikmeot [Ahiak Migratory Bird Sanctuary]

The Nunavut Planning Commission (NPC) has determined that this project proposal is outside the area of an applicable regional land use plan.
