For the moment, we are discussing with the company 'Wilf's expediting service' in Cambridge Bay. The company is able to manage the fuel burning, crushing and disposal of the barrels. Nevertheless, we are looking forward to have discussions with the contaminated site specialist for further information.

Also, we are not certain of the type of fuel contained. This is why we would like to plan a first field work season to take samples with a specialist and then come back the following year, well equipped, to clean the area properly.

We would like to clean up the area as soon as possible, as required by the Area Co-Management Committee from Cambridge Bay and Gjoa Haven by following the [10-step process of federal contaminated sites decision-making framework - Canada.ca](#).
