Specifically, the information requested to be submitted to the NIRB online application form includes:

- Authorizing agencies for the proposed project;
- Approximate number of personnel involved; and
- Facilities to be used in Resolute (accommodations, any other).

The NIRB is again requesting submission of the information as enclosed and for the information to be provided by **February 25, 2020**. If DND determines that the time required to supply the required information is significantly greater than one (1) week, the Board requests written notification and an anticipated date for submission be provided as soon as possible.
