Please find the following submission by Jeetaloo Kakee, Board Member Amaruq Hunters and Trappers Association (AHTA), and Meeka Mike, Technical Advisor (Member) AHTA for draft agenda for the April 12-21, 2021:

1. Further to a motion that was presented by Jeetaloo Kakee at the February Public Hearing in Iqaluit and Pond Inlet to be given opportunity for questions on the Terrestrial Environment presentation. The procedure for the opportunity to ask questions as per the procedures under Article 12.2.23 and 12.2.24(a)
 - (a) *to the extent consistent with the broad application of the principles of natural justice and procedural fairness, emphasize flexibility and informality, and , specifically*
 - i. *allow, where appropriate, the admission of evidence that would not normally be admissible under the strict rules of evidence, and*
 - ii. *give due regard and weight to the traditional Inuit oral communication and decision-making; and*

(b) with respect to any classification of intervenors, allow full standing to a DIO
