**Re: Update to Baffinland Response to Comments Received by MHTO Concerning Engagement on Outstanding Phase 2 Technical – March 2020 to Present**

Further to Baffinland Iron Mines Corporation's (Baffinland) submission of October 14, 2020, Baffinland submits the following update on its efforts to engage with the Mittimatalik Hunter and Trappers Organization (MHTO) from March 2020 to present.

The attached submission is an update to Baffinland's filing of October 14, 2020 to reflect written and email communications with the MHTO since that time, and to reflect several entries that were inadvertently missed in the original filing. This summary does not include detailed references to meetings that took place between Baffinland and MHTO during the period of March 2020 to present. It also does not include summaries of engagements relating solely to the approved project.


