## PROJECT SCOPE:

The proposed “Kugluktuk Quarry Sites” project is located within the Kitikmeot region, approximately 4 kilometres (km) from Kugluktuk. The Proponent intends to extract aggregate from two (2) quarry sites to meet the construction demands of the community of Kugluktuk. The program is proposed to take place from January 23, 2021 to January 23, 2031. The scope of this proposed project as identified by the NIRB includes the following undertakings, works or activities:

- Operation of two (2) quarry sites to extract aggregate for community construction needs and will remain active until all its aggregate is depleted;
- Use of existing access road(s) to quarry sites;
- Use of heavy equipment including a front-end loader, dump truck, water truck and a crusher to crush large material; and
- Use of Hamlet’s facilities and supplies.
