As part of the regulatory approval process for Baffinland Iron Mines Corporation's (Baffinland) Mary River Phase 2 Proposal (Phase 2 Proposal), transboundary impacts must be considered in accordance with the international Convention regarding Environmental Impact Assessment in a Transboundary Context (Espoo Convention: February 25, 1991). Denmark (Greenland) has been identified as an Affected Party under the Espoo Convention, which may experience transboundary impacts associated with the Phase 2 Proposal.
