



The KWB has heard on multiple occasions that impacts of the all-weather access road (AWAR) on the Qamanirjuaq caribou have been felt by communities throughout the Qamanirjuaq range. This suggests that there is already an impact on caribou which is not being assessed by the current monitoring and mitigation measures. AEM had committed to a regional approach that integrates IQ and science through the creation of a Terrestrial Advisory Group (TAG). While the KWB supports the approach, it should be noted that HTOs and the KWB do not currently have the capacity to participate in the TAG.
