The Kitikmeot Inuit Association (“KIA”) has taken over control and management of the Grays Bay Road and Port Project (the “Project”) from its wholly owned subsidiary the Nunavut Resources Corporation (“NRC”). The Project was under Review by the Nunavut Impact Review Board (“NIRB”) until early May 2018 when NRC requested that the NIRB proceeding be suspended under section 143 of the *Nunavut Planning and Project Assessment Act*.
