Re: Additional Information Required: Information Request # 2 for Qikiqtaaluk Corporation's "Qikiqtaaluk Inshore Fisheries Research" Project Proposal

Dear Jesslene Jawanda:

On April 7, 2021 the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB or Board) received a referral to screen Qikiqtaaluk Corporation's "Qikiqtaaluk Inshore Fisheries Research" project proposal from the Nunavut Planning Commission (Commission), which noted that the project proposal is outside the area of an applicable regional land use plan. The activities associated with this proposal were previously reviewed by NPC on June 30, 2020. However, on August 28, 2020 the NIRB suspended assessment activities for the screening of the project proposal (NIRB File No. 20YN019) until additional information requested from the proponent is received.

Pursuant to Article 12, Sections 12.4.1 and 12.4.4 of the *Agreement between the Inuit of the Nunavut Settlement Area and Her Majesty the Queen in right of Canada (Nunavut Agreement)* and s. 87 of the *Nunavut Planning and Project Assessment Act*, S.C. 2013, c. 14, s. 2 (*NuPPAA*), the NIRB has commenced screening this project proposal. Due to the proposal containing activities that are sufficiently related to previously assessed activities under NIRB file number **20YN019**, the NIRB has assigned this proposal with this previous file number. Please reference this file number in all future related correspondence.

On April 26, 2021 the NIRB requested that the Proponent complete the online application form through the NIRB's public registry system and ensure, pursuant to s. 144(1) of the *Nunavut Planning and Project Assessment Act*, S.C. 2013, c. 14, s. 2 (*NuPPAA*), that sufficient information is provided to determine the scope of the project activities being proposed and to commence screening.

On May 10, 2021 the NIRB released a formal letter requesting that the Proponent provide the Board with the information necessary in order to carry out the screening of the project proposal.

The NIRB followed up on numerous occasions via email (May 26, 2021) requesting an update on when the information would be provided. To date, the Board has not received the requested information or notification regarding when the information would be made available. Please note that if the Proponent fails to submit the requested additional information, the Board may suspend the assessment activities of the proposed project pursuant to s. 144(2) of the *NuPPAA*. Therefore, it is in Qikiqtaaluk Corporation's best interest to cure the identified information deficiencies in a timely manner.

The NIRB is again requesting submission of the information as enclosed and for the information to be provided by **June 3, 2021**. If Qikiqtaaluk Corporation determines that the time required to supply the required information is significantly greater than one (1) week, the Board requests written notification and an anticipated date for submission be provided as soon as possible.
