PROJECT SCOPE:

The proposed “Qikiqtani Marine Renewable Energy Resource Assessment” project is located within the Qikiqtani (North Baffin) region, with five (5) communities to be determined. The Proponent intends to assess the Marine Renewable Energy (MRE) potential for the 13 hamlets in the Qikiqtani region. The program is proposed to take place from June 2021 to July 2022. The scope of this proposed project as identified by the NIRB includes the following undertakings, works or activities:

- Desktop data collection in all 13 communities through discussions with the communities and various relevant organizations, followed by a selection of five (5) communities with the highest potential;
- Hiring of local crew members and vessels in each community to conduct research;
- Use of multibeam sonar to perform transect measurements.
- Use of vessel-mounted Acoustic Doppler Current Profiler (ADPC) to perform transect measurements in the selected communities;

Parties are also invited to recommend any specific mitigation measures they feel would be appropriate, and to bring any other matter of importance related to this project proposal to the NIRB’s attention.
