Here are our comments:

All fueling will be done away from water sources. In the unlikely event of a fuel spill, spill kits will be available during all project activities that require fuel.

Fuel will only be stored onsite during project activities. Fuel and white gas will be stored in approved containers. Fuel will be stored upright, in well ventilated areas, and out of direct sunlight. A bear fence is available at one location to prevent wildlife from contacting fuel and a bear monitor will be present at both locations.

After the project proposal was submitted to NPC and NIRB, and after further discussion with community members who use the land near the restoration sites, we decided that Dexpan would not be necessary. Use, handling, and storage of Dexpan will not be required for project activities.
