This letter is a formal invitation for you (or your delegate) to attend the upcoming Kivalliq Socio-Economic Monitoring Committee (KivSEMC) meeting scheduled for October 6th and 7th, 2021 in **Rankin Inlet** at the Singiituuq Complex (community hall).

The annual KivSEMC meeting is a platform to **discuss the social and economic changes experienced by Kivalliq communities** as a result of major mining projects. These discussions can help come up with ways to **maximize benefits to communities** and **minimize negative impacts**.

Strict COVID-19 public health measures will be implemented to ensure the safety and comfort of all KivSEMC meeting participants. This will include measures such as hand sanitizing stations, sanitation of meeting equipment (headsets, microphones, writing utensils), and physically distanced seating.
