Completely disapprove of the river crossing on the road coming from the quarry, as I saw a destructive use from a recent project that used the river crossing and did not even care enough to return the road conditions to their original or equivalent form, for this big type of project and if there is a approval for the river crossing I can predict this will absolutely have disruptive damages, if not destroy the fishing ground that is just a km up from this river, over the years I've seen this fishing ground thriving in healthy numbers in perfectly health conditions and each year more and more locals participate in their traditional practices, a lot could potentially go wrong in the course of the project oil/gasoline spills, a disturbance to the migration seasons, especially in the amount and frequency that is required for this project and as for the terrain concerns there is a huge snow pile up in the winter/spring that spans out from the tank farm barrier to the proposed floating docks location and stretch out all along the tank farm's sand/gravel barrier which it could potentially be maintenance issue in few years
