This email is a follow up to the Suspension of Assessment of Activities issued by the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB or Board) dated, September 5, 2018 for the University of Saskatchewan's "Potential Impacts of New Perfluorinated Compounds on Arctic Char" project proposal (NIRB: 18YN042; NPC: 148914)

The NIRB requests that the University of Saskatchewan provide an update to confirm whether the company expects to re-engage the assessment process for the "Potential Impacts of New Perfluorinated Compounds on Arctic Char" project proposal and if so, when can the NIRB expect the material to be submitted?

Should you wish to resume the assessment in the future, a written request must be filed directly with the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB) we would then commence screening of the project proposal.

Please note that if such a written request has not been filed within three years of the suspension date of September 5, 2018, the assessment of the project will be terminated as per section 143 (4) of the Nunavut Planning and Project Assessment Act (NuPPAA). You would then have to re-apply through the Nunavut Planning Commission (NPC).
