**Re: Land Use Report Calendar Year 2020 — NIRB File #15EN009**

Tundra Copper Corp. (“Tundra”) holds Class “A” land use permit N2015C0009, which was issued on July 21, 2015 and expires on July 20, 2021. This permit authorizes Tundra to conduct exploration activities on Crown lands. The corresponding water use licence is 2BE-COP1721, which was issued on June 19, 2017 and expires on June 18, 2021. Please consider this letter a report on annual land use activities for calendar year 2020.


**Activities**

The Hope Lake Camp located on 1:50,000 NTS map 86N08. The WGS84 latitude and longitude coordinates are listed below:

**Latitude:** 67° 26' 3.61878"  
**Longitude:** -116° 25' 1.35984"

In 2017 the Hope Lake Camp was demobilized by Kikiak Contracting Ltd. of Kugluktuk. Phase one of the demobilization occurred between March 3, 2017 and April 17, 2017. Demobilization efforts were carried out by winter trail. Activities were intermittently delayed by severe winter weather. The second phase of the demobilization commenced on July 24, 2017 and was completed on July 27, 2017. Phase two activities were undertaken by fixed wing air access. No Tundra camp facilities, fuel caches or equipment are currently located in the project area. No field exploration work occurred in 2017, 2018, 2019 or 2020.
