Oceans North objects to the admissibility of the video which was just played and ostensibly prepared by IUOE Local 793. This material as introduced and read into the transcript clearly fails admissibility guidelines established by the board's rules of procedure and fails to meet any standard of admissibility for a Canadian quasi-judicial tribunal. My understanding is that the board introduced this video with some qualifications that new facts presented will not constitute evidence in these proceedings. This is insufficient.

This video is factually inaccurate, falsely represents the project proposal, appears to be coercive, and falls within any normal definition of propaganda. This video is culturally offensive and racist.

Allowing it to remain on the record will be a stain on these proceedings and will further undermine confidence in a fraught process.
