On February 1, 2022 the Nunavut Impact Review Board (NIRB or Board) received a referral to screen Universite de Montpellier's "Shift-eDNA" project proposal from the Nunavut Planning Commission.

The NIRB is emailing to determine if you have any questions regarding the NIRB's online public registry system and the next steps to commence the screening of the project proposal.
