**OBJECTIVES OF RESEARCH:**

Worley Canada Services Ltd. and Ikpiaryuk Services Ltd. in joint venture, operating as Advisian-Ikpiaryuk JV, have been retained by Public Services and Procurement Canada and Fisheries and Oceans Canada – Small Craft Harbours to perform community consultation, regulatory support services, and detailed design for the development of a small craft harbour in the Hamlet of Arctic Bay, Nunavut. This harbour is part of the Inuit Impact and Benefit Agreement negotiated for the Tallurutiup Imanga, National Marine Conservation Area, which was announced on August 1, 2019. Arctic Bay is located within the North Baffin Regional Land Use Plan Region on the northwest coast of Baffin Island.

**TERMS & CONDITIONS:**

The holder of the licence will be bound by the terms and conditions of the Nunavut Impact Review Board Screening Decision Report and the Department of Culture & Heritage archaeological sites terms and conditions. 
