The proposed “Nunavut Uranium Project” is located within the Kivalliq region, approximately 90 kilometres (km) from Baker Lake. The Proponent intends to conduct uranium exploration activities. The program is proposed to take place from Summer 2022 to September 2023. The scope of this proposed project as identified by the NIRB includes the following undertakings, works or activities:

- Use of helicopter for day trips for exploration activities
- Conduct site investigation on Aberdeen Lake and in the vicinity of Gerhard Lake
- Use of snowmobiles, ATVs, Snowcats, and Deltas
- Drilling conducted from June to September
