Re: Exploration activities by QEC for Geothermal Resource potential in Baker Lake.

Baker Lake Council had a discussion regarding the potential of geothermal resources and are delighted with the QEC proposal to explore the potential of Geothermal resources in and around our community.

We are aware that presently fossil fuel is employed for electricity generation and heating application all over the Nunavut territory including our community. We appreciate that burning fossil fuel, which must be imported by sealift, is associated with many serious risks and concerns, including high cost of deployment, environmental degradation and health issues. Baker Lake Council therefore strongly supports QEC efforts to explore and employ possible Renewable Energy resources that can reduce and eventually replace the fossil fuel for all the electricity and heat applications in our territory.

We now understand that QEC conducted a geothermal resource assessment and feasibility study exercise in 2018 and the said study results have identified our community as one of the few with possible geothermal resources. QEC has advised us of their intention to collect further data by surface exploration drilling/testing and other activities in and around our community. Results of this exercise can confirm the study results and help with the making of a plan to exploit the geothermal resources for heat/electricity application, if economically feasible.

This letter is intended to express full support /cooperation and participation assurance of the Baker Lake to QEC for their proposed geothermal resource assessment exercise. We are keen to participate in the activities and will provide all help that we can including providing available information helping data collection and making land available for QEC activities if requested.
