PROJECT SCOPE:

The proposed “Scenic Cruises – Unlocking the Northwest Passage” project is located within the Qikiqtani and Kitikmeot regions. The Proponent intends to conduct vessel-based tourism activities that would provide passengers opportunities to engage in flightseeing, zodiac cruising, underwater excursions, kayak excursions, wildlife watching, shore landings for guided interpretive walks, and organized community visits. The program is proposed to take place in August 2022. The scope of this proposed project as identified by the NIRB includes the following undertakings, works or activities:

- Use of a fleet of twelve (12) zodiacs to facilitate shore landings and sightseeing excursions
- Use of a 6-person submarine for underwater excursions.
- Use of cruise vessel, the Scenic Eclipse, for transportation and accommodation of up to 200 passengers
- Use of helicopters for aerial sightseeing
