PROJECT SCOPE:

The proposed “Coral Harbour Solar and Energy Storage Project” is located within the Kivalliq region, approximately 10 kilometres (km) from Coral Harbour. The Proponent intends to undertake geotechnical assessment and construct a utility-scale renewable energy and battery storage system in Coral Harbour. The program is proposed to take place from 2024 to 2054. The scope of this proposed project as identified by the NIRB includes the following undertakings, works or activities:

- Installation and operation of ten (10) rows of solar PV arrays
- Construction of an access road to the project site
- Installation of transmission line corridor that aligns with the access road
- Installation of a microgrid controller platform
