PROJECT SCOPE:

The proposed “3BM-REP2126 Municipal Water License Amendment and Renewal” project is located within the Kivalliq region, within Municipal boundaries of the community of Nauyasat. The GN – CGS, on behalf of the Hamlet of Nauyasat, intends to construct a single cell lagoon and amend the discharge effluent limits in the existing water licence to service the growing population of Nauyasat. The program is proposed to take place from July 2023 to 2043. The scope of this proposed project as identified by the NIRB includes the following undertakings, works or activities:

- Construction and use of a single cell lagoon adjacent to current wastewater disposal site
- Use of heavy equipment for the construction of lagoon
- Construction of access road to new lagoon site
- Amendment of discharge effluent limits to service the growing population of Nauyasat
