




## COMMENT FORM FOR NIRB SCREENINGS

<p><b>Do you have any suggestions or recommendations for this application?</b></p> <p>Transport Canada (TC) is in direct discussion with CIRNAC to clarify aspects of this application, including Lots 541/542. For NIRB's record, TC is noting the following:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• TC does not own or operate Coral Harbour Airport. The Remedial Action Plan maps on pages 78 and 86 list the Coral Harbour Airport and Active Airstrip as Transport Canada property. The Coral Harbour Airport was transferred to the Government of the Northwest Territories (GNWT) via the GNWT Arctic B Airport Transfer Agreement in 1995, later to Nunavut when the new territory was created.</li> <li>• An Aeronautical Assessment Form for Obstacle Notice and Assessment may be required for this project. This form is available online at <a href="https://tc.canada.ca/en/aviation/general-operating-flight-rules/marking-lighting-obstacles-air-navigation">https://tc.canada.ca/en/aviation/general-operating-flight-rules/marking-lighting-obstacles-air-navigation</a>. The notice and assessment process is not an approval process. It is a notification of the work occurring. If there could be an impact on air travel, Transport Canada, Civil Aviation will be in touch with the proponent.</li> </ul>
