  - 83 Inuit (66 Kitikmeot) > 12
- Employee turnover 35% for TMAC direct employees, 40% for Inuit





- Inuit Impact Benefit Agreement (IIBA) signed April 2018
- Inuit Employment (2019)
  - 310 employees worked at the project ,
  - 49 (16%) of which were Inuit
- Contracting (2019)
  - \$27.1 million in expenditures
  - 59% of total made to 86 northern businesses including Kitikmeot Qualified Business


