RE: Exploration activities by QEC for geothermal resource potential in Cambridge Bay

The Municipal Council is encouraged with the QEC proposal to explore the potential of geothermal resources in and around our community.

We are a community of **Ingenuity** and have been very interested in developing alternative sources of energy to reduce the amount of fossil fuels currently used and to reduce the cost of having to do so. We recognize that our current system are having a devastating effect on our environment, and at the same time as we pollute the earth we are contributing to the high cost of surviving in Cambridge Bay.

We strongly support QEC efforts to explore and employ any renewable energy resources that will reduce and eventually replace the need for fossil fuel in our territory.

We understand that QEC conducted a geothermal resource assessment and feasibility study exercise in 2018. We have been advised that the results of this study have identified our community as one of the few in Nunavut with possible geothermal potential for which we are incredibly excited.

QEC has advised us of their intention to collect further data in and around Cambridge Bay using methods of surface exploration, drilling/testing and other activities as may be required. We are hoping that the results of this exercise will positively confirm the study results and create a strategy to develop geothermal resources in our community.

By Motion of Council on Wednesday, July 25th, we are expressing full support for your proposed geothermal resource assessment exercise. We are keen to participate in the activities and will provide all help that we can.
