
Scope


- Addition of underground mining at the Pump, F Zone, and Discovery deposits, which were previously approved for openpit mining;
- Extension of the operation phase (i.e. mine life) by 11 years to 2043;
- Increase in employment to 905 employees with associated camp expansion










Waste Management:


- Continued use of existing waste management infrastructure;
- Addition of waste rock storage facilities, temporary salt waste rock piles, landfarms, a landfill and a composter;
- Option to store waste rock and tailings in exhausted pits





