PROJECT SCOPE:

The proposed “Naujaat Solar and Energy Project” is located within the Kivalliq region, approximately 0.75 kilometres (km) from Naujaat. The Proponent intends to construct and operate a utility-scale solar energy array and battery storage system in Naujaat. The program is proposed to take place from June 2023 to December 2055. The scope of this proposed project as identified by the NIRB includes the following undertakings, works or activities:

- Construction of a 1.05 MW 13-row solar PV array including crystalline panels, inverters, transformers, electrical meters, connection equipment, 1 MW battery, and battery storage over an area of four (4) hectares
- Construction of an access road
- Construction of a temporary camp consisting of up to four (4) trailers connected to a generator and serviced by municipal water and sewage
- Up to two (2) gravel hauling trucks to deliver gravel for the access road construction;

- a type where the potential adverse effects are highly predictable and can be prevented/managed appropriately with known technology.

Parties are also invited to recommend any specific mitigation measures they feel would be appropriate, and to bring any other matter of importance related to this project proposal to the NIRB’s attention.
