Canadian Aviation Regulation 302.10(h) states: “No person shall, at or in the vicinity of an airport, knowingly display a marker, marking, sign, light or signal that is likely to be hazardous to aviation safety by causing glare or by causing confusion with or preventing clear visual perception of a marker, marking, sign, light or signal that is required under this Subpart; ...” If the solar panels are found to cause hazardous glare to flight crews, immediate actions will be required to eliminate that hazard.
